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### **Additional Eyebrow Care**

**Please Note:** Immediately after your procedure, your eyebrows may appear too dark, too thick and with an unnatural “drawn in” appearance. It is only when healing is complete that you will be able to fully appreciate the color and softness of your eyebrows. Most of the time, they will actually heal too light, which will be corrected during the “perfecting session.”

- You may wear eyeshadow but take care not to get any on procedure area.
- Never use your fingers to apply vaseline. Use a clean Q-tip to apply the vaseline. No fingers!!
- Apply vaseline 4-6 times daily (a light coating only) for 5-7 days until eyebrows are healed - usually one week. This keeps dust particles out of pigmented area and allows pigment to heal in skin. Before bathing and sleeping, apply an additional light coating of vaseline to the eyeliner.
- Do not let the full pressure of the shower hit your tattooed area for one week. The water may run down your face, tho.
- Any possible itching in procedure area may be alleviated by pressing with a clean Q-tip. Do not rub, pick or peel off any pigment in procedure area during the healing process - you will remove pigment. A light peeling or scabbing may occur, this is normal.
- No sun, sauna, jacuzzi or swimming in chlorinated water or the ocean until the procedure is healed.
- Do not strenuously exercise until procedure is healed if you are prone to headaches.

**REMEMBER:** Like any cosmetic procedure, this is a process. Do not expect immediate results. **Please** be patient. It will be a few weeks before you can fully appreciate the results. **And** you will love it!!! Thank you.
