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Additional Eyeliner Care

PLEASE NOTE: Immediately after procedure, the eyelids may or may not appear slightly swollen and/or bruise (you may cover any bruising with concealer). Because of swelling the eyeliner may appear to be much thicker and sometimes distorted; the color will appear to be extremely dark, even when soft colors are used. **DO NOT WORRY!** In 1-2 days, the liner will be reduced to the desired thickness and will be more even as the swelling goes down. However, the color will remain dark until the healing process is complete (approximately 7 days). At this point, your liner may be too light, uneven, "not enough," etc. Relax, when you return for your "perfecting session," we can adjust/add as much as you desire. Some additional tips:

- Do not curl your eyelashes for one week after eyeliner procedure.
- Do not wear any makeup on tattooed area for one week after procedure.
- Do not let the full pressure of the shower hit your tattooed area for one week.
- Use a clean Q-tip to apply healing products and to remove any excess pigment from eye area. No fingers!!
- Any possible itching in eyeliner area may be alleviated by pressing with a clean Q-tip.
- Apply healing product 4-6 times daily, (a light coating only) for 5-7 days until eyeliner is healed - usually one week. This helps to keep dust particles out of tattoo and lets pigment heal in tattoo.
- Before bathing and sleeping, apply an additional light coating of healing product to the eyeliner.
- No sun, soap, sauna, jacuzzi, swimming in chlorinated water or in the ocean until the eyeliner is healed.
- Do not rub, traumatize or pick or peel off any pigment in eyeliner area during the healing process - you will remove pigment.
- To prevent headache (if you are prone to them), do not strenuously exercise until procedure is healed.

REMEMBER: Like any cosmetic procedure, this is a process. Do not expect immediate results. **PLEASE** be patient. Do not be concerned if some of the pigment disappears; your perfecting session will take care of this. It will be a few weeks before you can fully appreciate the results. **AND** you will love it!!!
